How do you take part in the race?

An advert calling for entries usually appears in the British Homing World and on the RPPRA website around the end of September and the list stays open for about four weeks until capacity is reached. A deposit of 50% of the entry fee is required, with full payment being made before birds are accepted at the loft. The loft is open to receive bird entries from mid February to the end of March.
